

Dan Aldag, Cal Poly Humboldt



Dan Aldag has taught at Cal Poly Humboldt since 1994 and received the university's Excellence in Teaching Award in 2013. At CPH, he leads the Jazz Orchestra and the Jazz Combos and teaches trombone and courses in jazz and popular music. Under his leadership, the Cal Poly Humboldt Jazz Orchestra has developed a reputation for innovative programming and inspired playing. Recent special performances include the complete Sweet Time Suite by Kenny Wheeler, Swingposium (in collaboration with San Jose Taiko), concerts with guest artists Jason Marsalis and Ryan Keberle, a collaboration with Matt Wilson's Christmas Tree-O, and centennial celebrations of the music of Charles Mingus, Thelonious Monk, Billy Strayhorn and Gil Evans. In 2024, the Jazz Orchestra received an award from the Doug Davis Composition and Performance Endowment.

Dan regularly performs on trombone with the North Coast Brass Ensemble and Low Class Jazz and writes arrangements for both groups. He has played behind many jazz and popular artists, including Dizzy Gillespie, Louie Bellson, Joe Williams, Bob Hope, the Temptations, Diane Schuur, Bobby Caldwell, and the Manhattan Transfer.

Dan's compositions and arrangements for jazz band, brass quintet, and trombone have been published by Ensemble Publications and Really Good Music, performed throughout the United States and Europe, and recorded on the Seabreeze Vista label.

A strong advocate for jazz education, he frequently works with middle school and high school jazz bands, adjudicates and clinics at jazz festivals, directs honor jazz bands, and created a jazz pedagogy course for music education majors at Cal Poly Humboldt.

Dan is a founding board member of the Redwood Jazz Alliance, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization which brings jazz artists to Humboldt County for performances and educational workshops. Through his work with the RJA, he has helped to present more than 100 internationally-known artists,

Dan holds degrees from the University of North Texas, the University of Illinois, and California State University, Fresno.

Dr Jeffrey Benson, San Jose State University



Jeffrey Benson is currently the Charlene Archibeque Endowed Professor of Choral Music and Director of Choral Activities at San José State University. He also serves as Artistic Director of Peninsula Cantare, a community chorus based in Palo Alto, CA. The Washington Post hails his choirs for singing “with an exquisite blend, subtlety of phrasing, confident musicianship and fully supported tone.”

Dr. Benson made his international conducting debut with the Irish Chamber Orchestra and the SJSU Choraliers in Limerick, Ireland in 2016, and he made his Carnegie Hall conducting debut ten years ago. He has served as cover conductor for the Grammy award-winning Washington Chorus, where he helped to prepare the ensemble for Maestros Leonard Slatkin and Marvin Hamlisch.

This season, Benson returns to Carnegie Hall to conduct Elaine Hagenberg’s *Illuminare* and Mozart’s *Requiem* with orchestra and chorus, and he recently conducted Craig Hella Johnson’s *Considering Matthew Shepard* at the Washington National Cathedral with Berkshire Choral International. In the past few years, Dr. Benson’s choirs have been invited to perform with the Rolling Stones, Josh Groban, Andrea Bocelli, Sarah Brightman, the Los Angeles Festival Orchestra and the Skywalker Orchestra.

Dr. Benson is a published composer and arranger, and is the editor of the Jeffrey Benson Choral Series with both Santa Barbara Music Publishing and Gentry Publications. His own compositions are published with Colla Voce Music and Santa Barbara Music Publishing, under the Charlene Archibeque Choral Series.

Benson is Past President of the California Choral Directors Association (CCDA) and currently serves on the National Advocacy and Collaboration Committee for the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA). He received his Master’s degree and his Doctorate in Choral Conducting/Music Education from The Florida State University and his Bachelor’s degree in Music Education from New York University.

Chris Alexander, Accompanist

Chris Alexander (Santa Rosa) has accompanied the NorCal Honor Choir for almost every year since 2001. He graduated in music from Stanford University, and while living in the Peninsula and South Bay, performed with the San Jose State Chorale (including a 2000 tour to Scandinavia and Russia), TheatreWorks of Palo Alto (including world and west coast musical premieres), the Gilbert and Sullivan Society of San Jose, the Redwood Symphony and other groups, including 11 years as accompanist for the Stanford Savoyards. Since moving to Santa Rosa in late 1999, Mr. Alexander has served variously as music director or pianist for 6th Street Playhouse in Santa Rosa, Spreckels Theater Company in Rohnert Park, Raven Players in Healdsburg, Cinnabar Opera Theater in Petaluma, Sonoma Arts Live, Novato Theater Company, and choirs at Sonoma State University, as well as the service musician at First Congregational of Santa Rosa. During the day, Mr. Alexander works in Public Health for Sonoma County, and would like to thank his wonderful wife, Dana, (choral director at Montgomery High School, Santa Rosa), and their teenage daughter.

Dr. Angelina Gomez, Chico State University



Dr. Angelina Gomez is the Director of Bands at California State University, Chico where she leads the Wind Ensemble, Concert Band, Pep Band, and Clarinet Choir. She also teaches conducting and music education courses, studio instruction in clarinet and saxophone, and supervises the student chapter of the National Band Association. Dr. Gomez maintains an active schedule as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and rehearsal clinician throughout Northern California.

Originally from Santa Rosa, California, Dr. Gomez received her degrees from Sonoma State University, Washington State University, and the University of Kansas. Her conducting mentors include Danh Pham, Paul Popiel, Matthew Smith, and Andy Collinsworth. Prior to her appointment at Chico State, Dr. Gomez held similar posts in Santa Rosa City Schools and the Wright Elementary School District.

Dr. Gomez is a member of the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), the National Band Association (NBA), the National Association for Music Education (NAfME), the California Music Educators Association (CMEA), Women Band Directors International (WBDI), and is an honorary member of the Tau Beta Sigma National Honorary Band Sorority.

Dr. Gomez thoroughly enjoys collaborating with students and colleagues to make wonderful and meaningful music. She hopes to inspire students to enjoy making music throughout their lives just as her mentors and teachers inspire her.
