Scales:

- a major scale of your choice (2 or 3 octaves)
- a melodic minor scale of your choice (2 or 3 octaves)
- chromatic scale (2 or 3 octaves, starting on any note)

Repertoire:

- A lyrical etude or a lyrical movement from an etude, sonata or concerto (excerpts are acceptable).
- A technical etude or fast movement from an etude, sonata or concerto (excerpts are acceptable).
