The **Sonoma State University Brass Ensemble** is made up of music performance and education majors as well as interested students from outside of the music department. The ensemble studies and performs a wide variety of music for large and small groups of trumpets, horns, trombones, euphoniums, and tubas. Our repertoire includes transcriptions of Renaissance, Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and Modern music as well as original pieces composed specifically for brass instruments. In addition to preparing music for concert performance, students in the Brass Ensemble study and rehearse the standard repertoire most often played by working professional brass quintets.

Daniel Gianola-Norris is a familiar sight to audiences throughout the San Francisco Bay Area, where he is active as an orchestral musician (most often with Santa Rosa Symphony) and trumpet soloist. An accomplished multi-instrumentalist, Daniel has performed professionally on a broad assortment of instruments including trumpet, French horn, flute, didgeridoo, hurdy-gurdy, and ukulele. He can be heard playing several of these on the soundtracks to the video games Sam and Max and Wallace and Gromit's Grand Adventures. A graduate of California State University, East Bay and the Peabody Conservatory of Music, Daniel is trumpet instructor at Sonoma State University and Santa Rosa Junior College.
