**Major Joseph S. Hansen** serves as the Commander and Conductor of the United States Air Force Band of the Golden West at Travis Air Force Base, California, a 60-member musical unit comprised of eight different performing groups with a 5-state area of responsibility serving Air Mobility Command.

Prior to this command assignment, Major Hansen served as an opinion leader engagement action officer for the Secretary of the Air Force Office of Public Affairs. He was the think tank engagement advisor and liaison for the Chief of Staff and Vice Chief of Staff of the Air Force, as well as senior Pentagon and MAJCOM leaders, and was responsible for developing and implementing public support and understanding of Air Force roles and missions.

Previously, Major Hansen served as assistant director of operations and flight commander for the United States Air Force Band, Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington, D.C. During his tenure with the band, he served as officer in charge of the Concert Band, Singing Sergeants, Air Force Strings, and Max Impact as well as overseeing the unit's marketing, operations, and resource sections.

He deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom (2014) and Operations Inherent Resolve and Freedom's Sentinel (2018) to Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar and served as the U.S. Air Forces Central Command (AFCENT) Band officer in charge. Through his leadership, deployed bands traveled to Afghanistan, Iraq, Egypt and 10 other countries performing for 50,000 military and local audience members on over 250 missions.

Major Hansen began his Air Force career in 2009 as deputy commander of the USAF Band of the West at Joint Base San Antonio, Texas. In 2011, he planned and directed the band's first combined concert with the San Antonio Symphony.

Prior to joining the Air Force, Major Hansen was a band and orchestra teacher in Colorado Springs, Colorado. He graduated with honors from Brigham Young University with a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education in 2006. He went on to complete his Master of Music degree from Southern Oregon University through the American Band College in 2009. Major Hansen graduated with Doctor of Musical Art degree in Music Education from Boston University in 2021.



**Andy Collinsworth** has been the Director of Bands at Sonoma State University since 2008, where he leads the university Symphonic Wind Ensemble and Concert Band, teaches Instrumental Conducting and serves as Chair of the Music Department.

During a career that spans 32 years and counting, Dr. Collinsworth brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the courses he teaches in conducting and music education. He maintains an active schedule as a rehearsal clinician and guest conductor with a multitude of band and music education organizations throughout the western states. In addition to his duties at SSU, he leads the Saint Helena Community Band, an ensemble established and sponsored by renowned director Francis Ford Coppola. He is the founder and an instructor for the Sonoma Summer Wind Band Conducting Symposium, an annual weeklong conducting seminar for music educators. He is the coordinator of the Sonoma Invitational Wind Band and Orchestra Festival—a signature three-day event featuring high school ensembles that is an affiliate of the Music for All National Concert Band Festival, sponsored by Yamaha. Dr. Collinsworth was awarded the 2022 Outstanding Music Educator Award by the California Music Educators Association Bay Section.

Andy Collinsworth holds degrees in Conducting (DMA, 2008 Arizona State University (2008), Saxophone Performance (MM, 1989 University of Nevada at Reno) and Music Education (BME, 1987 University of Nevada at Reno).
